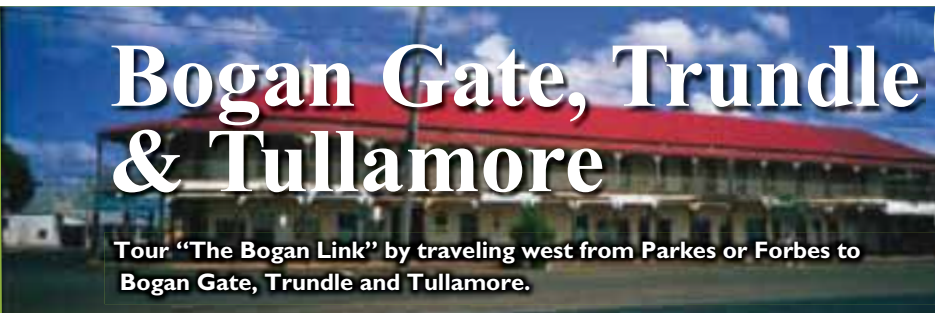

Bogan Gate, Trundle & Tullamore

Tour "The Bogan Link" by traveling west from Parkes or Forbes to Bogan Gate, Trundle and Tullamore.

BOGAN GATE

Located approximately 30km to the west of Parkes, Bogan Gate features a quaint Pub, a must-see General Store & Gift Shop, and just across the road you will find a Craft Shop in the old Railway Station which is open weekends and public holidays.

TRUNDLE

Trundle is situated 65km north-west of Parkes. Picture yourself here standing on New South Wales' widest main street, next to the longest wooden verandah in Australia! This famous verandah belongs to the Heritage Listed **Trundle Hotel**, built in 1909. The two storey hotel was built out of pise mud, rendered with cement and adorned with a 90 metre long wooden verandah. There are no problems with making an angle park in Trundle. Forbes Street lays claim to being one of Australia's widest main streets, measuring 66 metres (216 ft) across. The annual Trundle Bush Tucker Day is a yearly highlight on the first weekend of September.

TULLAMORE

Tullamore is best known for its **Tullamore Irish Festival**. What does the Tullamore in Australia have in common with the Tullamore in Ireland?... not a lot geographically - but they sure know how to party like the Irish!! This annual festival is held over Easter and celebrates Tullamore's strong Irish links, as many Irish born settlers moved into the area in the 1900's. Memorial Park offers the playground facilities and rest rooms.
