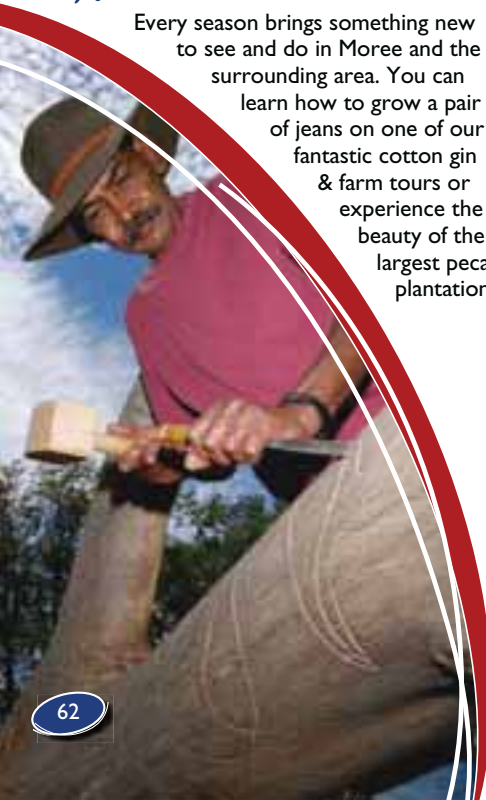

The thermal water is pumped directly from the Great Artesian Basin upon which Moree sits and is naturally heated to 41.6 degrees Celsius. One spa is cooled to 38 degrees for patrons' convenience.

The Complex also features an outdoor 50 metre heated Olympic pool which is maintained at a year round temperature of 27 degrees. A shaded children's play pool and splash pool are also available for the younger patrons and their families.

Interested in visiting an Artesian Baths without loads of people around you?

The town of Boomi is located near the border of NSW & Queensland, one hour NW of Moree or one hour west of Goondiwindi, via bitumen roads.

Both Lightning Ridge and Queensland can be accessed after a pleasant stopover at the quiet and well shaded Artesian Baths in Boomi.

The Boomi Artesian Bore draws artesian water from a depth of 1,222 metres (4,008 feet) and has been used to swim in since it's construction

in 1906. Construction of the present day baths was commenced in 1975 and the latest addition of the sea baths was in 1996. Accommodation

consists of caravan sites and a furnished, air-conditioned cottage both adjacent to the Pool complex. Pets are welcome!

Rooms and Meals are also available within a short walk at the Pioneer Hotel. We have a 25m cold Artesian pool, a wading pool and a Hot Artesian

Spot Pool with numerous spa jets that will soothe those aches and pains. Facilities available adjacent to the pool and caravan sites include a coffee

shop, general store with groceries, fresh fruit and vegetables and light meals, BBQ and tennis courts. Other activities and interests are tennis,

nature reserve birdwatching,

fishing in the Boomi or Barwon Rivers and self guided history walks. Farm tours can be arranged. Please book ahead.
