Classified by the National Trust as an Urban Conservation Area, Narrandera is also noted for its expansive street trees, parks and gardens.



The Murrumbidgee River and Lake Talbot create a superb pocket of nature encompassing the Lake Talbot Holiday Complex, and a nature reserve incorporating the Bundidgerri Walking Track and Koala regeneration area. The River Redgum forest that hugs the Murrumbidgee is a fisherman's paradise with lots of great camping spots in good weather.

Take the heritage walk to appreciate the many lovely old buildings. The "Lavande Aromatiques" Lavender Farm, Parkside Museum, Dolls collection, Tiger Moth Memorial, Royal Doulton Fountain, big Fig Tree and John O'Brien Monument add interest. A mix of boutique shopping, antique and novelty stores makes a coffee shop or bakery the logical next stop.

Families will enjoy a visit to the Narrandera Fisheries Centre, and in the warmer months, the Lake Talbot Swimming Complex.

A round of golf on one of country Australia's top golf courses is a must. Bowlers can have a roll at one of the friendliest clubs there is.

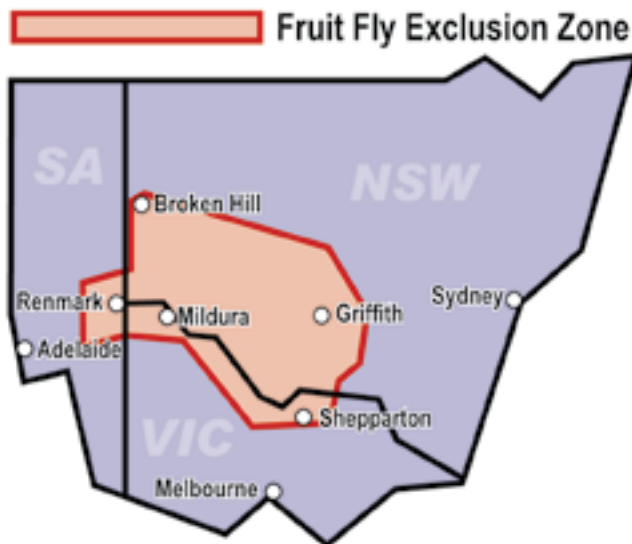
