A short-cut with a difference

If you're looking for a short-cut with a difference, turn off the Newell at the charming village of Tomingley and make the most of a visit to Narrromine.

Travelling west? Narrromine is where you come to meet the magnificent plains of the central west. Straight roads, an abundance of native wildlife and beautiful sunsets are all part of our appeal. You can then continue your journey by rejoining the Newell just south of Gilgandra. This alternative route is just 3km further but provides a peaceful bypass to Dubbo.

Things to do:

- Experience Narrromine's world famous thermals in an aeroplane, glider, or ultralight;
 - Encounter the history of aviation at the Narrromine Aviation Museum at Narrromine aerodrome;
 - Marvel at the workmanship of the locally built full size operational Wright Flyer replica;
 - Stop and smell the flowers at the famous Swane's Rose Nursery and Narrromine Iris and Geranium Farm;
 - Dine with the Alpacas at Andonbel Alpaca Coffee Shop in a train;
 - Enjoy the tranquillity of the Macquarie River – throw in a fishing line whilst picnicking at one of the many river reserves;
 - Visit Australia's largest lime orchard and souvenir their delicious organic products;
 - Observe the hustle & bustle of an operational cotton gin (April – July);
 - Trek along one of the various walking tracks in Goobang National Park;
- Browse through the locally made hand crafted gifts in the craft shops at Narrromine and Trangie;
 - Visit the historic country pubs in Trangie, all 3 hotels date back to the early 1900's (Royal Hotel -1900, Imperial Hotel -1916 & Trangie Hotel -1929);
 - Stop and enjoy a break in one of Narrromine's beautiful parks;
 - Relive the past with a visit to the local history room located within the library.

Make Narrromine your home base, centrally located with a great selection of accommodation options including caravan parks, hotels, motels, farm stay or B&Bs and is ideal for day trips to many attractions including Dubbo Zoo, Parkes Radio Telescope, Macquarie Marshes, and the Goobang and Warrumbungle National Parks.
