On the majestic Murray

Friendly Tocumwal on the majestic Murray River invites you to enjoy the area's many attractions and activities.

Tocumwal is a thriving small rural town situated on the Murray River and flanked by massive red gums. It boasts some of the largest strips of sand along the Murray with 25 beaches close to town. The riverside beaches are a popular camping spot for travellers, who come here to go bushwalking, fishing for Murray Cod, bird-watching, boating and swimming.

Tocumwal, which took its name from an Aboriginal word "Tocumival" meaning "deep hole" began life as a river port. A bridge along the Murray, constructed in 1895, connected the town with Cobram on the Victorian side of the river. Tocumwal was an important customs depot and river port and today the surrounding fertile lands are used for wheat, dairy, rice, wool, cattle and citrus production.

During World War II the Aerodrome at Tocumwal was the largest in the Southern Hemisphere and used as a training base for Liberator bomber pilots.

- Take a step back in time and explore old farm machinery and curios at Chrysties Museum;
- Take to the river and bush on a Big Wheels Water Adventure Tour, the ultimate off-road, in water, four wheel drive experience;
- Play golf on the President's or Captain's Course;
- The Tocumwal Historic Aerodrome Museum at Tocumwal Visitor Information Centre;
- The Blowhole Reserve, a deep waterhole sacred to local aborigines;
- Take a scenic flight over the mighty Murray, learn to glide or just enjoy the ride;
- Tocumwal Foreshore Market and Tocumwal Regional Farmers Market.
